Data Gathering

The web form survey has been posted to the University Life website, and shared with students via University Life's weekly communication to students. It may also be shared with faculty and staff via Public Affairs' newsletter. The committee is also conducting informational interviews and organizing focus groups, and exploring how to conduct a survey in the Spring. Training and Other Capacity Building

Members of training and other capacity building subcommittee have continued to attend and evaluate trainings using the SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats) analysis rubric. They have completed over 15 trainings so far, predominantly for proprietary guards. Next week, the group will focus on online modules completed by contract guards. The group is drafting preliminary recommendations for the report.

Comparative Research

The comparative research subcommittee has sent out survey questions to universities that have similarities to Columbia and has so far heard back from eight universities. The subcommittee's student reps have also begun outreach to student groups across similar universities. The group will aggregate this information for the upcoming report.

 - The group will generate a cumulative report, sharing current observations and recommendations, for President Bollinger and the Community, to be submitted the week of December 14, 2020. The group's work will continue forward after

that time, as there remains more information to be gathered, data to be analyzed and recommendations to be developed based on this analysis.
